

Osceola County Collection Guidelines



Curbside Garbage Service

- Collected once per week.
- Garbage must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Place all garbage in provided cart. Place cart(s) at least 4 feet away from any other objects such as mailboxes, cars, other carts, etc.
- Yard waste, construction debris and hazardous materials should not be commingled with garbage.

Curbside Recycling Service

- Collected once per week.
- Recyclables must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items accepted for collection include: Steel/tin/aluminum cans, plastic jugs and bottles, flattened corrugated cardboard, newsprint, paper bags, phone books, mixed paper and magazines.
- GLASS IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED WITH RECYCLABLES.

Yard Waste Service (This includes grass clippings, weeds, pine needles, leaves, tree branches, limbs, palm fronds, etc.)

- Yard waste must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Yard waste is limited to 3 cubic yards total (approx size of one large sofa) or 10 waste cans, yard waste bags, or individual items (see larger individual items below).
- Twigs, small branches, grass clippings and leaves must be contained in a waste can or a yard waste bag. Each can or bag cannot weigh more than 50lbs.
- Larger individual items (such as branches):
 - Cannot be larger than 4ft in length
 - · Cannot be larger than 6 inches in diameter
 - Cannot weigh more than 50lbs.

Bulk Waste Service

- Bulk waste collection is once per week.
- Bulk waste must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Bulk waste includes large items such as furniture and is limited to 3 cubic yards per week.
- Bulk waste collection does not include collection of appliances or construction materials.

White Goods Service

- White goods collection must be scheduled by the resident by calling ADS Customer Service at 407-605-3892.
- White goods must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- White goods are domestic appliances such as Refrigerators, Ranges, Water Heaters, and Freezers, etc.
- For safety reasons, please remove doors from refrigerators/ freezers or tape the doors shut.

Holiday Schedule

There is no collection on the following holidays: New Years Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. All service days will be pushed back by one day following the holiday. For example, if collection in your area is scheduled for Tuesday, the same day as the holiday, then pick up will be on Wednesday. Folks scheduled for Wednesday will be collected on Thursday, Thursday scheduled collection will be picked up on Friday and so forth. Friday collection will be moved to Saturday.
